1. INTRODUCTION

5. PROCESSING PROCEDURES

The Data may be processed by third parties operating as Data Controllers such as, by way of example, authorities and supervisory and control bodies and in general public or private bodies entitled to request the Data.

Your Data may be processed by third parties designated as **data processors** who perform specific activities on behalf of the Data Controller (such as, inter alia: accounting, tax and insurance-related requirements, management of admission tickets and other procedures required for the provision of services), service partners needed for the organization of the show (for example, travel agencies; airlines; car services, for accessory services relating to travel or accommodation). In some cases, the Data may later be processed by the same recipients in a capacity as independent data controllers.

Data shall be processed by persons in charge and duly trained, and shall not be disclosed and disseminated.

Your Data will not be transferred to countries outside the EU.

8. PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

We are hereby informing you that by accessing the exhibition grounds, you accept the possibility of being accidentally filmed by audiovisual equipment belonging to various subjects. Considering the characteristics of this type of event, we cannot guarantee exclusion from such activities. The Data Controller may also produce short films featuring the various shows, sometimes for reporting purposes, and it may occur that identifiable subjects are accidentally filmed. Any photos or videos taken by the Data Controller will always be checked before publication to ensure that the possible impact on the visitor's personal data is as limited as possible.
